Dear Colleagues,

further to our invitation to the seminar "**Legal Metrology & EU Directives, New Legislative Framework**" which will be held on 3 and 4 November in Zagreb, Croatia we would like to draw your attention to some of the most relevant topics which will be presented to the participants.

One of such topics is the Legislative Framework (NLF) which consists of three legal texts:

- [Regulation \(EC\) No 764/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 July 2008 laying down procedures relating to the application of certain national technical rules to products lawfully marketed in another Member State and repealing Decision No 3052/95/EC.](#)
- [Regulation \(EC\) No 765/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 July 2008 setting out the requirements for accreditation and market surveillance relating to the marketing of products and repealing Regulation \(EEC\) No 339/93](#)
- [Decision No 768/2008/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 July 2008 on a common framework for the marketing of products, and repealing Council Decision 93/465/EEC](#)

The implementation of the NLF has required from Member States to make important administrative and regulatory changes at the national level in the field of accreditation and in the field of market surveillance and controls on products from third countries. Some of the experiences of Member States will be presented at the seminar.

The Decision No 768/2008/EC will also effect the provisions of NAWI and MID.

As you might have been be informed the MID is currently under the

revision due to the Article 25 of MID and the public consultation is in progress (you can get more information at http://ec.europa.eu/enterprise/sectors/legal-metrology-and-prepack/public-consultation/index_en.htm).

The seminar will also address the Services Directive which needed to be fully transposed by Member States into their national systems by the end of 2009. The Directive required the Member States to simplify procedures and formalities that service providers need to comply with and to remove unjustified and disproportionate burdens.

We would like again to ask you to register your experts who are responsible for the implementation of the above mentioned legislation into your national legal system.

The deadline for the registration is **15 October 2010**.
